

# Silicone

100% Silicone is non-porous & hypo-allergenic. Clean it with soap & warm water or use toy cleaner. Solid silicone toys can be sterilized in a pot of boiling water.

# Cyberskin

Cyberskin and other similar realistic-feeling silicone blends are porous & can never be truly sterilized. Clean them with soap & warm water, rinse well, and air dry. Consider using a condom with these toys.

# Glass/Metal

Glass and metal toys are hard, non-porous materials. Clean them with soap and water, rinse, and towel.

# Cleaning Sex Toys

## Jelly

Jelly is a porous material that can never be truly sterilized. Clean with a toy cleaner & air dry. Consider using a condom with these toys for the most hygienic use. Don't allow jelly or plastic toys to touch as they will stick!

## Plastic

Plastic toys (i.e. polyurethane & PVC) may have seams that can trap bacteria. Clean them with soap & warm water or toy cleaner, rinse well, & towel dry.

## Battery/Electric

Refer to cleaning instructions for the material of the toy. Be careful not to get water near the battery compartment. For non-waterproof electric toys, do not get water near the cord or charging port. Many USB rechargeable electric toys are waterproof (clearly stated on the packaging). For these, use warm soapy water to clean, rinse, & air dry.
